

Environmental Procedure

1. Purpose

2. Policy and Core Commitment

3. Scope

4. Environmental Stewardship Standards

Our responsibility is expressed through the development and maintenance of standards that safeguard the environment:

- **4.1 Pollution Prevention:** We shall implement and adhere to the highest international standards for pollution prevention, including strict procedures for the handling of waste oil, chemicals, and hazardous materials in accordance with the **MARPOL Convention**.
- **4.2 Responsible Waste Management:** We strive to minimize waste through responsible resource management and recycling. This includes:
 - **4.2.1 Reduction at Source:** Systems to minimize waste generation before it occurs.
 - **4.2.2 Reuse and Recycling:** Maximizing the reuse and recycling of waste materials, both at sea and ashore.

5. Climate Responsibility and Carbon Footprint
